Dear friends and family,

July 2021

The "Yea's" have it! This past year, our church was willed a piece of property with a house on it. It was given with the intention of being used as the church parsonage. My family will be looking to live there, easing the financial burden for the church, for myself, and for future pastors as well.

The yard was filled with trash, and the property was overgrown with bush. We had several men and teenagers give of their time and energy to help clean up the yard. Once that project was finished, we brought some contractors to the house so that we might get an estimate to repair the house.

One of the contractors gave us an estimate of \$45,000 to repair the structure. That includes repairing the roof, replacing some walls, subdividing some bed rooms, replacing some windows, and installing two bathrooms.

I presented this project to our church people, and they voted to move forward with the project! They are excited about it, and they plan on giving financially "to their power, yea...and beyond their power".

However, we can't do this alone. We are also asking you to consider praying and asking the Lord if He might have you encourage this church by helping with this project financially. The contractors' quote only includes the shell of the house, but does not include things like: electrical, plumbing, kitchen cabinets, furniture, and a cistern (tank for collecting rain water to drink). These additional items will cost \$113,000, bringing the total cost to \$158,000. Our church people are excited about giving, and are even excited to learn to give more by faith than they ever have before. They are excited about seeing what the Lord will do. Our church, Trinity Baptist is looking to raise \$30,000 over the next few years, and we are asking you to consider helping with the additional \$128,000. We can't do it alone. We ask you to help hold the ropes as we continue to gather the necessary funds and build.

Our theme is: "Let's Build Together!" In Creole, it says, "Ann Bati Ansanm!"
Our theme verse is: Acts 20:35 It is more blessed to give than to receive.
